



Why do you think there will be conflict?



"It's Mine!"

- Land claims cause clashing between the parties
- Dutch removed as a threat when England has New York
- Spanish threat from Florida
- French entire west border

Ohio Valley Conflict

- Settlers cross the Appalachian Mountains
- "Drive from the Ohio River any European foreigners, and do it in a way that will make them lose all taste for trying to return"

Native Americans Choose sides

- Natives did not want French/British
- Picked a side in the hopes of having a say

French Allies

- French were trappers and traders
 - Did not destroy land (British would for farms)
 - Married natives and adopted their ways
 - Algonquins
 - Hurons (Negotiators for the French to other Native tribes)

British Allies

- Native customs not adopted/rights not respected
- Iroquois Nations
- Mohawk Chief
 - Joseph Brant
- Lower prices on trade gained support
