

## English setbacks

- Edward Braddock
  - ordered to attack FortDuquesne
  - 1,300 troops cutdown by half

# Britain gains ground

- William Pitt
  - 1757 head of British government
  - British gain Iroquois support



#### The French fall...

- Pitt sends James Wolfe to take Quebec
  - Moves up a cliffside
  - Wolfe dies but the city is captured Sep. 18, 1759
